What is Child Find Screening?

Screening is a free check of a child's developmental areas, including large muscle development, eye-hand coordination (fine motor skills), communication, concepts, personal-social skills, self-help skills, vision, and hearing

The purpose of the screening is to identify any factors that may interfere with a child's learning, growth, and development.



Who May Come to Screening?

Any child who is three or four years old and lives in the Bloomfield School District, including the Blanco School attendance area.

What Happens After Screening?

The Preschool Assistance Team (PAT) meets to review the child's file, including scores from the screening, developmental history, and any parent concerns about the child.

The PAT will determine one of the following:

- **The child showed some areas of concern and the team recommends <u>more testing</u> to determine if there is a developmental delay.
- **The child appears to be typically developing and there are no concerns at this time.

One of the Child Find team members will contact you within 10 business days to discuss the results with you.
